Michigan State Council Bowling Mixed Tournament

Rules and Regulations

1. *Early entry closing date is September 24, 2023 unless schedule is filled sooner. If space permits tournament manager will accept entries up to squad time.*
 2. *Multiple participation is allowed if multiple squads are assigned but a bowler can only cash once. Youth bowlers may not bowl in this activity (substitute or pace included) which offers cash prizes (Reference USBC Youth Rule 400).*
 3. *Individuals who are members of bowling organizations identified as "professional" are eligible for participation, however, not more than one pro on a four-member team. Any bowler is considered a "professional" until 2 years after membership expires.*
 4. *Tournament will consist of mixed team event (2 men & 2 women / 3 men & 1 woman / 3 women & 1 man). Teams must have a member(s) in good standing with the Knights of Columbus prepared to present a current membership card for check in.*
 5. *HANDICAP: The handicap for this tournament is 90% of the difference between entrant's highest average and 230. Maximum handicap is, 100 pins per game / 300 pins per series.*
 6. *Prize ratio for team will be one in eight.*
 7. *Prize fund will be returned 100%.*
 8. *Entering Average Rule: Entrants must use their highest USBC sanctioned league average regardless of whether bowled as a regular member or substitute. Averages will be accepted in the following order:*
 - A. *Highest 2022-23 book average of at least 21 games.*
 - B. *If A does not apply, highest 2021-22 average of at least 21 games.*
 - C. *If Ruling A or B does not apply, a current league average of 9 or more games as of date of participation will be accepted.*
 - D. *If none of the above apply, then the entrant must use the scratch figure of 175 men and 150 women.*
 - E. *It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.*
- Corrections in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game bowled in the tournament, or within 48 hours after completion of the series if the tournament manager, prior to the completion of the first game, has given written consent to the bowler authorizing such extension of time to correct their average.*
9. *If breakdown of pin spotters occurs for 10 minutes, tournament director reserves the right to move bowlers to another pair of lanes. Bowlers being moved will not receive any practice throws on the new pair of lanes.*
 10. *Captains (K of C Member) will be informed of schedule dates and times. Prize checks are sent to team captains, so it is important to include their full mailing address and telephone number.*
 11. *To speed up the check in process, it is important that each Team Captain K of C Member ID number be included on this entry blank. All line-ups entries must appear in the order they will bowl.*
 12. *USBC Rule #319d, the reporting of previous tournament prize winnings in excess of \$300 has been waived.*
 13. *All entries must be paid in full when submitted. **THERE WILL BE A \$50.00 NSF FEE.***
 14. *Tournament management has the right to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior.*
 15. *The Bowling Center and/or Tournament management may play fun music.*
